## Triads and Chords

## Quick Study of Triad Constructions

Triad: is a three-tone chord consisting of superimposed thirds. The bottom note (in 1st position) is the root; the middle note is the third and the top note is the 5th (scale intervals of the given Key).


## Root Positions \& Inversions

Inversions: the Root (bass) of the chord moves in 3rds or 5ths while respelling the Triad in an alternate form.
